(a) Program Fee Payment Schedule

The total program fee for the 2024-25 intake is HK\$318,000 (excluding all related bank handling charges, remittance fees and differences due to the exchange rate). The program fee covers tuition, textbooks and course materials for some general core courses and required courses.

The program fee will be paid in TWO installments in addition to the deposit upon accepting the offer:
